Vilom is an extension of a lettering piece designed for a book titled Drukchintan (दृक्चिंतन), a compilation of essays on works of Modern artists from India and the world.

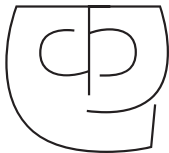
In the spirit of Modern art, Vilom attempts to break away from tradition and experiments with the visual form of the Devanagari script. While the solid rectangles and circles of the Dandas(दंड) and Bindus(बिंदू) dominate the visual space, the thin lines define character shapes; a fine balance of abstraction and legibility.

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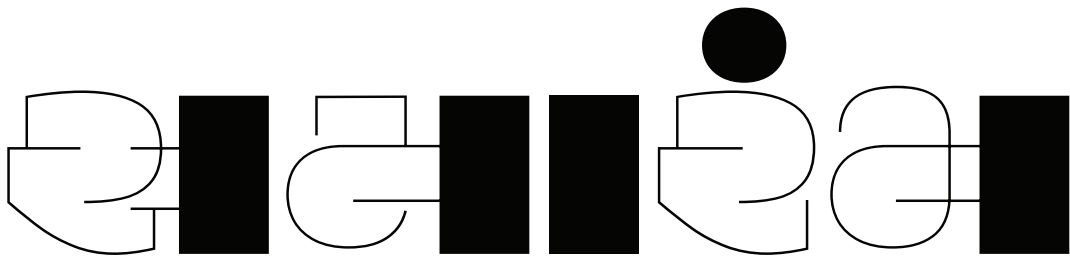
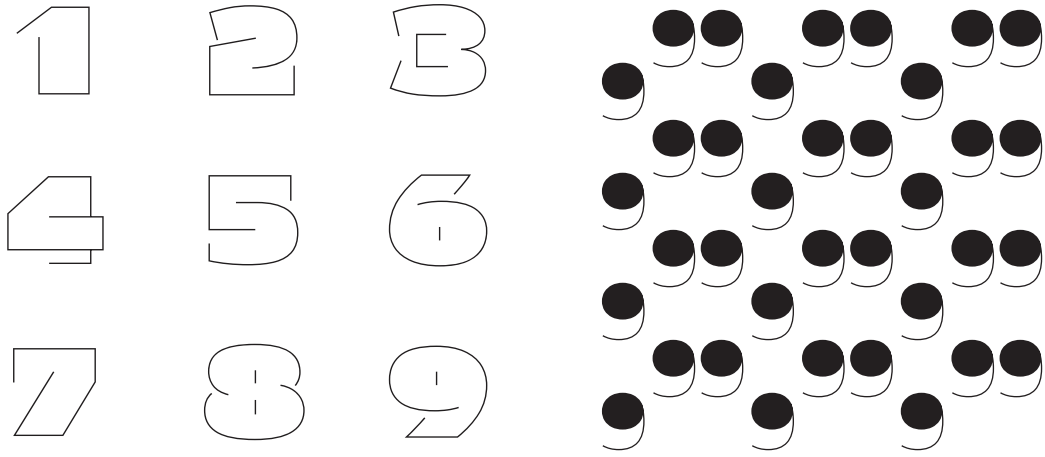
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Vilom | Devanagari Specimen

Vertical Conjuncts



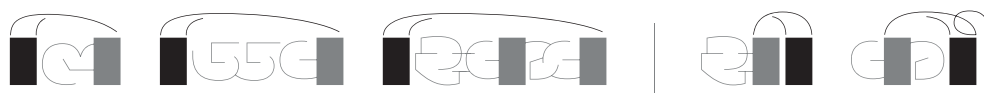
